<p>School accessible for all children and adults – accessibility plan</p> <p>Loud voices</p> <p>Clear speech</p> <p>Position of children in the class (hearing and vision impaired children)</p> <p>Clear displays</p> <p>Flexible teaching arrangements e.g. Seating, pupil able to move at will to access lesson</p> <p>Medicine administered following NYCC policy</p> <p>Allow thinking time</p> <p>Access to lip-reading</p> <p>High colour contrast materials, including on whiteboard</p> <p>Visual aids</p>	<p>Co-ordination group – physical co-ordination activities done in small group</p> <p>Handwriting and / or fine/ gross motor programmes</p> <p>Teacher aware of implications of sensory and physical impairment e.g. not covering mouth when talking to pupil with hearing impairment / light implications for visually impaired and lip readers.</p> <p>Spelling support</p> <p>Availability of resources e.g. writing slopes, matt laminates, pencil grips</p> <p>Develop note taking skills</p> <p>Pre-writing activities warm up- 'dough disco', 'squiggle while you wriggle'.</p> <p>Grip development/ grips available</p> <p>Subject vocabulary dictionary</p> <p>'Wake up shake up'</p>	<p>Position of TA and teacher</p> <p>Enlarged texts</p> <p>Enlarged test papers</p> <p>Pre and post teaching</p> <p>Extra time</p> <p>Individualised Provision maps</p> <p>Pre-populated work with date and other details on</p> <p>1-1 individual support in class to facilitate access to curriculum e.g. enlargement and adaptation of learning materials</p> <p>Individual arrangements for SATs</p> <p>Teacher use of resources e.g. radio aid for hearing impaired</p> <p>Provision of specialist equipment e.g. seating, ICT Individual handwriting / fine motor / keyboard skills training</p> <p>Additional planning and arrangements for transition</p> <p>Referral to Physical, medical and sensory team</p> <p>Referral to children's disability nursing team</p>
