Failure to return completed Parental Agreements may result in children losing their place.

Children across all year groups have been fascinated this week by the arrival of a number of beautiful butterflies! It has been remarkable to watch baby caterpillars stop eating, hang upside down, spin a cocoon or molt into a shiny chrysalis, eventually emerging as a stunning butterfly (or moth).

By way of a reminder 'Tiny Pixels' are at school on Monday 4th July taking Class Photos. If you DO NOT want your child to be included in these group images, please let the school know ASAP.

As I am sure parents/carers of children in Year 6 will be aware, Tuesday 5th July is KS2 SATs results day. We would like to reassure parents, carers and children that there is really nothing to be worried or anxious about and that whatever the outcome, as a school, we are extremely proud of all our children, their resilience over the past couple of unprecedented years and their ability to always try their best.
