Message from Mr Hiley

Earlier this week, Miss Webster sent home information to parents of children in Nursery, Reception, years 1 and 2 about this year's Christmas Production 'The Prickly Hay'. As explained in the letter, due to Covid we are limiting audience numbers. If you are parent of a child in Nursery, Class 1, 2 or year 2 in Class 3 then please remember to complete and return reply slips to secure tickets to performances by no later than Friday 10th December. Unfortunately, we will NOT be able to honour late responses.

This will be the first time the school has 'opened' its doors to parents for a very long time! This decision has not been taken lightly, and numerous considerations have had to be taken into account. We have worked with guidance from our partners at NYCC and the UK Health Protection Agency to ensure appropriate and proportionate risk assessments are in place. Please read the following information very carefully to ensure our event can go ahead safely and to avoid any possibilities of transmission which may have knock on effects for Christmas!

We would strongly recommend that any adults coming to any of the performances carry out a Lateral Flow Test even if asymptomatic. This is our first line of defence to help keep everyone as safe as possible.

On the day of the performance, we would ask that parents do not enter classrooms, but make their way directly to the School Hall where they will be met by a member of staff and seated. We are also asking that face coverings are worn at all times, unless you are medically exempt. In addition, please remember that taking photographs or videos of children performing is strictly prohibited.

It goes without saying, on the day of performances, if you have one or more symptoms of Covid then please DO NOT attend the performance. Please also consider not attending if you are not well with any other potentially contagious illness. As everyone will appreciate, there are also a lot of nasty coughs, colds and bugs doing the rounds at this moment in time and as I am sure everyone will agree, we need to limit the spread of any illness – it has never been more important to look after each other.

For those parents who will be bringing children back for the evening performance we would once again ask that

children are dropped off at classroom doors and parents do not enter classrooms.

At the end of the performance, can parents please make their way to the school playground where a member of staff will send children out to be collected.

We would also ask that parents do not enter the corridors in the school building. Whilst usually we would love to let parents have a wander around the school and take a look at our lovely displays, this year we are unfortunately unable to allow this to happen. Thanking everyone in anticipation for their compliance and understanding.

We will also be ensuring maximum ventilation in the hall which means we will have doors and windows open no matter what the weather so please come prepared! Many layers would be our recommendation!

Now on to other Christmas news and events!

On the 8th December, children in classes 1,2,3,4 and 5 will be taking part in a Nativity at the Auction Mart. We can now confirm that parents are welcome to attend this performance at the Auction Mart from 1.30pm onwards. In order to avoid any confusion and unnecessary mixing of adults and groups, at the end of the event we will be walking **all** children back to school for a usual collection time of 3.30pm. Please do not ask if you can take your child directly from the Auction Mart as this will really help us with our safeguarding and also ensure those children taking part in the Christmas craft session after school are all back at school ready for the fun!

Don't forget, our school Christmas Lunch will be taking place on Friday 10th December, and all children are invited to join in with this seasonal feast! Meals are priced at £2.10 per meal for children in Nursery, FREE of charge for ALL children in Reception, Years 1 and 2 and £2.55 per meal for children in years 3,4,5 and 6. Christmas Lunch is also FREE for all children eligible for Free School Meals. Payment should be made via Parentpay prior to the 10th December.

Also, on the 10th December is 'Christmas Jumper Day'. In return for wearing a Christmas Jumper or Christmas Accessories families are being encouraged to donate £1.00. All monies collected will go to a mental health charity. **To help with any confusion, Christmas jumpers should be worn over the top of school uniforms (jumpers**

We have several families who have expressly asked that their children do not feature on any photographs taken in school and it is an important safeguarding issue that we respect their wishes. If there is something specific you would like a photograph of, please have a word with your child's class teacher and we will be able to arrange it, if at all possible.

(Lateral Flow Device) test. By following guidance, we can help prevent the spread of Covid and protect our friends, families and communities. Advice from the Government continues to state:

“Do not use a rapid lateral flow test if you have COVID-19 symptoms as listed on the NHS website. [Get a PCR test](#) as soon as possible and [self-isolate](#), while awaiting the result even if symptoms are mild”.
