As a school we do fully appreciate that SATs can be a worrying time for children, but would once again like to reassure parents/carers that as a school we are, and will continue to do, our very best to reassure and support children, albeit in Year 2 or Year 6, through their SATs. Hopefully, this will alleviate some of our children's concerns and worries. We impress upon children that they can only do their best and do not pressurise them in any way.

As parents/carers, we would ask that you ENSURE children ARE IN SCHOOL during their SATs week and that children AVOID taking any time off. We would encourage parents/carers to also ensure that they help support children by making sure children are well rested, get a good night's sleep, stay hydrated and keep energy levels up by eating a well-balanced and healthy diet.

By way of a reminder, on the mornings of the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> May children in Year 6 are invited to arrive at school for 8.30am and join other children from Owl Class for a FREE SATs Breakfast in their

Classroom. If your child usually travels to school using school transport, and you would like them to join in with the early breakfast, it will mean that alternative travel arrangements to school will have to be made.

For children in Key Stage 1 (year 2) SATs will be taking place during the week commencing Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> May. Again, we would like to reiterate the importance of ensuring that children are IN SCHOOL and that taking any time off is AVOIDED. Thank you.

Despite the awful weather later this afternoon, we are heading towards Summer and, hopefully, some sunshiny days! With this in mind, can we please remind parents/carers about how as a school we believe in promoting Sun Safety to ensure all children and staff are protected from skin damage caused by the harmful ultra-violet rays in sunlight. As a school we do encourage children to:

- seek shade, particularly during the middle of the day.
- wear suitable sun-hats
- wear clothing that protects the skin, particularly for outdoor activities and school trips
- use a high factor sunscreen (SPF 15+).

We would ask that parents/carers encourage children to bring and wear a hat at school, and also encourage the use of longer sleeved shirts and longer shorts when children are outdoors.

Parents/carers are asked to apply a long-lasting sunscreen BEFORE school. Sun-screen will only be required at school for use during school trips and will have to be applied by children whilst being supervised by staff. Please also remember that school does not permit the use of aerosol sprays.

This year we are once again hoping to take part in Bentham Show. Mrs Chapman will be sharing more information with children shortly.

As many readers may have seen, this year we once again entered the infamous Wray Scarecrow Festival with a rather fabulous 'Room on the Broom' creation. I am absolutely delighted to announce that our Scarecrow was awarded SECOND PLACE! WELL DONE to all our Year 6 children for creating this marvellous straw-person and to Mrs Chapman for all her support.

Following this week's Governors Meeting, I would like to welcome Mr Saville onto our Board of Governors. Mr Saville joins our Governing Body as a Local Authority Governor and brings with him a wealth of educational knowledge and experience.

We do still have a vacancy for a Co-opted Governor. Following a skills audit, it was identified that the Board potentially has a 'knowledge' gap in the field of construction/surveying. Unfortunately, due to the structure of our Board, the vacancy cannot be filled by a parent/carer of a child who is currently registered at the school. #### Sateguarding Information – Keeping Children Sate

#### Are your child's immunisations up to date?

With one in ten children in England not up to date with their vaccinations and at risk of becoming seriously unwell, this World Immunisation Week (24-30 th April) we are encouraging people to make sure they are up to date with their routine vaccinations at all life stages.


In particular, we are asking all parents to check if their children are up to date with their MMR vaccines to protect them against measles, mumps and rubella. To become fully protected children need two doses, the first at age one year and the second at 3 years 4 months.

The World Health Organisation (WHO) have predicted a rise in measles cases across Europe in 2023, making it is more important than ever to make sure that your child is fully protected. Measles can make a child seriously unwell and can lead to pneumonia with rare long-lasting conditions such as blindness and brain damage.

To make sure your children are up to date check your child's red book or GP records and make an appointment to catch up any missed doses.
