Message from Mr Hiley

Welcome back after the Christmas Holidays. I hope that everyone managed to have a wonderful Christmas and would like to wish all readers a very Happy New Year.

I would like to also welcome our new families to our school community whose children have, this term, started their educational journey and joined our wonderful Nursery provision. We hope that everyone has already settled into school routines and quickly settled into class.

Unfortunately, over the festive season, the infection rate of the new Omicron variant of Covid has quite literally taken off with confirmed cases in the local community and nationally significantly rising on a daily basis.

Earlier this week I sent out information in the form of an FAQ (frequently asked questions) relating to Covid and its impact on School. Summarising, as a school we would strongly encourage parents/carers to test their children for Covid, irrespective of whether any symptoms of infection are present at least twice per week. For those parents who may be concerned about swabbing children and the discomfort of self-testing, FlowFlex kits are now available. Swabs from these kits need only be taken from the nasal passages. If your child shows any one or more symptoms of Covid (headache, sickness, sore throat, fatigue, cold-like symptoms) then please keep your child at home and follow isolation rules. Please ensure that a lateral flow test is undertaken. Confirmatory PCR tests are no longer necessary. If a lateral flow test result is positive, your child will need to remain at home for at least seven days. On day 6 and day 7 following a positive test, further lateral flow tests should be undertaken (these tests should be taken 24 hours apart). If results from these tests are negative then and only then can your child return to school. If the test is still showing as positive then your child should continue to fulfil ten days of isolation. Again, whilst the virus is so prevalent amongst communities we would ask that parents/carers continue

to wear face coverings when both dropping off and picking up children from school. Thank you.

As previously reported in the Friday News, Mrs Susan Richardson and Miss Hannah Wilson have now joined the team of staff at Bentham C P School. Mrs Richardson is teaching children in Nursery whilst Miss Wilson is teaching in Class 2. I am sure everyone will join me in extending a warm welcome to both new members of staff.

By way of a reminder, if your child is currently in Nursery and due to start full-time school in September 2022 (Reception), then you need to apply for a place by no later than 15th January 2022. Please remember that even if you have a sibling that already attends school, or if you are 'in catchment' you still need to apply for a place in Reception.
