

Message from Mrs Pearson and Mrs McGregor

It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas in school and sounding like it too from the beautiful singing coming from all areas of school. From our very youngest in Early Years, to our eldest in Year 6, it would be impossible to miss some sort of festive activity going on in any one of our classrooms at any one time! Which moves nicely onto this years Christmas Fair organised by our wonderful FOBS.

Last Friday evening our school hall was a hive of activity as the school welcomed parents, carers, children, families and the wider community back through its doors. We were even lucky enough to have a visit from Santa for the evening! A huge thank you to all our wonderful fundraisers, and to everyone who supported this year's event. The FOBS raised an astounding £1,198.70. Thank you. This money will be used to buy some new outdoor seating for the children to use at playtimes and lunchtime.

Unfortunately, as parents/carers may have seen in the news, there has been a national increase in cases of Scarlet Fever, an infection caused by Strep A. I can also confirm in the last two days we have had confirmed cases within school. A separate letter will be sent to all parents today regarding this. Please remember, if in doubt, contact your GP immediately. Whilst Scarlet Fever is a common childhood illness, and is not usually serious, it does need treating with anti-biotics to reduce the risk of complications.

It is due to the confirmed cases mentioned above that I have not been present in school some of this week due to being in the latter stages of pregnancy and the risk to myself and baby if I were to become ill with Scarlet Fever. I have very much missed the Christmas activities in school and hope that I am able to return to being in the school building and amongst the children next week. Please do phone or email school if you wish to speak with me and I will get back in touch with you.

On Wednesday, our Year 3 children visited the Victoria Institute in Low Bentham and sung a variety of Christmas songs to some of the older residents of Bentham. I am reliably informed that members of the audience were absolutely delighted with their after lunch treat. Thank you to our Year 3 children for putting smiles on so many faces.

Children from years 1-6 this week took part in a festive Carol Service at the Auction Mart. It was lovely to see children singing carols and taking part in this Service. As parents, you should all be proud of children, and especially of how they represent their school when out and about in the community.

Earlier today, our annual school Christmas Dinner took place in the school hall. I have been told that it was a wonderful feast and that all our children looked really Christmassy in their Christmas Jumpers and party hats! Thank you to our wonderful school cooks, Lila and John for putting on this amazing spread! As I am sure everyone will appreciate it is extremely hard work preparing and serving over 120 Christmas Dinners! Thank you.
