Message from Mrs McGregor

Yesterday I had to make the decision to partially close the school due to the increasing number of Covid cases amongst both children and staff. This decision was not taken lightly and I would once again like to apologise for any inconvenience caused to parents/carers. I know that it is extremely hard to balance childcare and work.

Unfortunately, the number of staff testing positive resulted in it being logistically impossible to maintain a fully operational school. With this in mind, and to avoid prolonging a continual cycle of increasing positive cases, I would once again like to encourage parents/carers to continue to regularly LFD test children and other family members if they are showing any signs of Covid, this includes coughs, colds, runny noses, sore throats, temperatures, sickness and diarrhoea. Please consider not sending children into school when they are poorly – there have been instances where children and staff have tested negative for Covid first thing in the morning, only to test positive later in the day. I am hoping these class closures act as a circuit breaker.

I would like to wish all those currently poorly with Covid a speedy recovery.

I am hoping to be in a position to up-date parents/carers by 3.00pm on Monday with information about the wider re-opening of the school. Whilst this may not be ideal for the purposes of making childcare arrangements, I would ask that parents/carers are patient with the school at this challenging time, as I am sure everyone will understand, it is very difficult to predict the ever changing infection rates at the school.

Again, with sincere apologies for any disappointment, a decision has been made to withdraw our football teams from the tournament that was taking place at Ingleton Primary School on Tuesday 15th March 2022. Just when we thought a little bit of normality was returning, it appears this is not now the case! Both myself and Mr Hogg are sure there will be plenty of further opportunities for children to take part in inter-school sporting events in the near future.

Following on from last week's Friday News, we do still have a small number of Red Noses available to purchase from the school office. Noses are priced at £1.50 each. To help raise even more funds for 'Comic Relief', this year on Friday 18th March 2022 (non-uniform day) we

are inviting children to come into school dressed as their favourite 'Super Hero' in return for a voluntary contribution of £1.00. This can be one of the more popular figures, an imaginary 'Super Hero' or someone that their child aspires to be like, e.g. a fireman, NHS worker, or, perhaps even a member of school staff.

Hopefully, next week, we will be sending a letter home about this year's Parent Interviews. We are still planning for these to take place face-to-face. Parent Interviews will be taking place on the evenings of Tuesday 29th March and Wednesday 30th March. There will also be telephone appointments available or those parents/carers who are unable to come into school.

Coach Mark Gunn has forwarded to school some information about the Bentham Easter Holidays 2022 Multi-Sports Camps and Activity Days which will be taking place on Tuesday 12th and Monday 25th April 2022. For more information, please see the flyer attached to this newsletter.

I will also be sharing some 'Key Messages' with all parents/carers that have been sent to school by North Yorkshire and York Children and Young People's Bowl and Bladder Service for circulation and reference.

I would like to thank PCSO Ruth Pearson and her team, who came into school on Wednesday this week and worked with children in Year 6 discussing the 'No More Knives or County Lines' campaign.

Finally, as per last week's Friday News, we do currently have TWO Parent Governor vacancies available on our Board of Governors. Whilst being a governor requires both hard work and dedication, it is also a rewarding role.
