## Dear Parents/Carers

On Monday afternoon I had the pleasure of taking Class 5 to Keasden Head Farm to take part in some tree planting. It was lovely to watch as children enthusiastically engage in this activity which supports conservation, wildlife and links to Global Warming. On Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> January parents of children in Class 2 are invited to join children, in class, **from 9.00am until 10.00am**. This is a lovely opportunity to join in with your child's learning and experience first-hand life in one of our classrooms. I promise Miss Richardson will not be handing out any spelling or maths tests!

Finally, despite several pleas on previous Friday News Publications, one-third of parents at the school felt that they could not contribute £2.50 towards their child's opportunity to watch 'Dick Whittington', this year's pantomime here at the school. The price of securing a production in our school hall was around £600.00. The Friends of Bentham School kindly agreed to help subsidise the cost of the Pantomime by meeting the school half way with the cost, however, due to non-payments it has meant that we have had to subsidise the experience by a further £100. As I am sure everyone will be aware, school budgets are getting tighter and tighter. Unfortunately, this shortfall in parental contributions now means that additional resources that the school planned to purchase, for example sports equipment or a new bike for EYFS cannot not be purchased. Thank you to those parents who did make a contribution.

Finally, a few trainers are sneaking into school on the ends of children's feet. Please can you ensure your child wears dark school shoes and not dark trainers.
