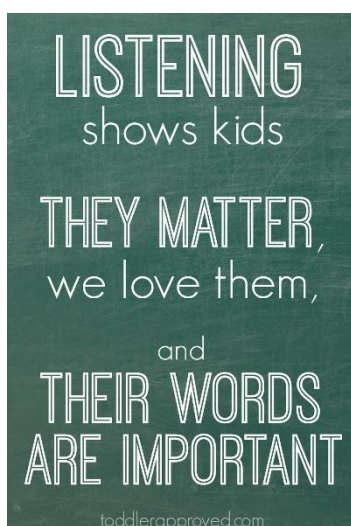

The Victorian Day was an amazing opportunity for children to explore the life and times of the Victorians. grandparents!) to choose other shows to book tickets for and prevent any double booking!

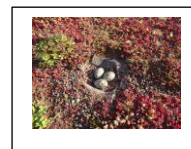
