Dear Parents

This afternoon I have been looking at the attendance of our children since we have returned to school at the start of September. Whilst I am aware that chicken pox has been doing the rounds, it is quite alarming how many children are currently deemed to be 'persistent absentees' due to their attendance being below 90%. Here are a few facts and figures for you:

- good attendance (96% or above) and punctuality best support all aspects of a child's progress and attainment at school and promote a positive work ethic;
- an attendance rate of 94% - 95% is considered a minimum level to support a child's progress and attainment at school;
- poor attendance (90% – 93%) can affect a child's learning, attainment and progress at school;
- attendance below 90% is considered unacceptable because it disrupts a child's learning, attainment and progress at school.

A total of 28 children in school currently have attendance that is below 90% with a further 16 having attendance between 90-96%. This is really concerning. A number of parents will be receiving letters informing them of their child's poor attendance and I would really appreciate your support in ensuring your child is in school every day. I realise that we all, at times, are unwell and need some TLC but I also know that sometimes we all feel a bit groggy on a morning but feel better as the day progresses. I would encourage you to bring your child to school on these days and if they do not get better, we would not hesitate to ring you.

So far, Class 5 are in the lead with the attendance trophy but Class 2 are not far behind. Let's see which class will win it this week!
