**URGENT REMINDER : Child Tax Credits/Working Tax Credits/Universal Credits** If you qualify for Universal

Credits then your child is ENTITLED to a Free School Meal. It is important that parents/carers apply NOW as new earning thresholds will be introduced by the Government as from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018. If awarded Free School Meals these will continue to be provided until at least 2022 – regardless of any increase/amendment to earnings. **Applications need to be made by no later than 31/03/2018. **Swimming Lessons** Following on from a previous edition of the Friday News, we have been contacted by The Pool Manager at Settle Swimming Pool. **North Yorkshire Fire and Rescue** have recently contacted North Yorkshire County Council and requested that they pass information onto parents about the dangers of fire.

Last year, North Yorkshire Fire and Rescue saw a spike in DELIBERATE fires over the Easter Holidays and are actively campaigning to reduce this number this year. North Yorkshire Fire and Rescue have asked for help from parents, this can be by simply checking on their children's plans and ensuring that matches and lighters are kept somewhere that isn't easily accessible. NY Fire and Rescue would like to remind parents that deliberately starting a fire is against the law, and even small fires can endanger lives. Fire spreads quickly and can be unpredictable.

Can we please request that parents do not bring children back to school if they are still poorly. This helps to reduce the risk of cross-infection and helps a child to recover from an illness. If children are prescribed medicine and there is a need for this to be administered during school time, please ensure that necessary paperwork is completed and medication handed into the School Office. Where medical advice has been ascertained and it has been recommended to keep children away from school whilst they are infectious, please can parents adhere to this advice.
