SCHOOL DINNERS Can we just remind parents that children should either commit to school dinners or packed lunches over the duration of a half-term. Unfortunately, due to the ordering of fresh provisions, we are unable to accommodate children taking a school dinner one day and bringing a packed lunch the next. The only EXCEPTION to this rule is where all full-time pupils are invited to take part in 'Fun-Day Fridays'. These are held EVERY Friday and are an ideal opportunity for children to try a school lunch. There is no need to pre-order and meals should be ordered by children during registration. Payment should be made via Parentpay and we would strongly encourage parents to ensure that Parentpay accounts are kept up-to-date. Thank you.

UNWELCOME VISITORS..... We have been made aware of some cases of children being diagnosed with 'worms' here at the school. Whilst these are unwelcome visitors they are a common problem, particularly in children. If a child is diagnosed with 'worms' it is essential that they are treated immediately.
