Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of Fairtrade Fortnight (26th Feb - 11th March) the children will be learning about Fairtrade in lessons and assemblies. In addition to this we are planning on holding a 'Fairtrade Treats' event either on Tuesday 6th March 2018 or Thursday 8th March 2018 in school from approx 3.30pm - 5.30pm.

The Fairtrade Treats event aims to raise money for the Fairtrade Foundation and will involve making and baking different recipes with Fairtrade ingredients. Some options may include banana breads, chocolate brownies, banana splits or crumbly banana squares with a drink of handmade lemonade which the children will make, bake and, most importantly, taste at the end!
